- 11:45 AM Clean up, wash hands , eat lunch, wash dishes, prepare for daily Chores.

In Matthew 28: 16, Jesus had told those Disciples that had walked with Him during His 3 years of Ministry here on earth to meet Him at a certain mountain. So remember that He was speaking to people that had already committed their lives to Him. Before you become a Disciple, You must commit your Life to Him and be trained by those that have been Discipled. It means forsake all and follow His plan for you.

This is why we have a six month orientation course for our potential Ministry Intern Students. We do not want anyone to commit to the full curriculum and time it takes until we teach them what it means to be a full time minister. We will in the first six months teach you basic understanding of the principals necessary to begin to get a comprehensive view of what you are signing up for. It took Jesus three years to build around 150 Disciples. There are instances in Scripture that says that some of His Discipleship Trainees were taught hard principals, decided to quit following Him. John 6:60 Therefore many of His disciples, when they heard this, said, “This is a hard saying; who can understand it?” John 6:61 When Jesus knew in Himself that His disciples complained about this, He said to them, “Does this offend you? 62 What then if you should see the Son of Man ascend where He was before? 63 It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing. The words that I speak to you are spirit, and they are life. 64 But there are some of you who do not believe.” For Jesus knew from the beginning who they were who did not believe, and who would betray Him. 65 And He said, “Therefore I have said to you that no one can come to Me unless it has been granted to him by My Father.” John 6:66 From that time many of His disciples went back and walked with Him no more. 67 Then Jesus said to the twelve, “Do you also want to go away?” John 6:68 But Simon Peter answered Him, “Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life. 69 Also we have come to believe and know that You are the Christ, the Son of the living God.”
